## **About the artist**

Dr. Danielle Breisach's exuberance and compassion permeate her performing and teaching. In demand as a collaborative musician and teacher, Dr. Breisach has performed all over the United States as well as Canada, Asia and Europe. In addition to teaching as Associate Lecturer of Flute at the University of Wisconsin – Stevens Point, she maintains a private studio of over 30 highly successful students in Madison, WI. Danielle also performs on low, Baroque and Celtic flutes.

As Co-Artistic Director of the Madison Flute Club since 2012, Dr. Breisach has extended the reach of the organization through founding the Chamber Ensemble, which gave its debut performance at the National Flute Association's annual convention in 2014. Additionally, Dr. Breisach founded the Middle School and High School Flute Ensembles in 2013, giving young, Madison-area flutists the opportunity to collaborate with one another and gain experience on piccolo, alto flute and bass flute.

Previously, Dr. Breisach has been on the faculty at Western Michigan University, Middleton High School, and the West Michigan Flute Association. She lives in Madison, WI with her husband Jeff, son Henri, and their two dogs and three cats. In her free time, she enjoys traveling to Bay View, MI, kayaking, hiking and reading.
