

One-Year Retention Rate Trend

- Retention rate increased each year for three consecutive years from 65% to 71%
 - 66% - 2009 freshman cohort
 - 65% - 2010 freshman cohort
 - 66% - 2011 freshman cohort
 - 68% - 2012 freshman cohort
 - 71% - 2013 freshman cohort

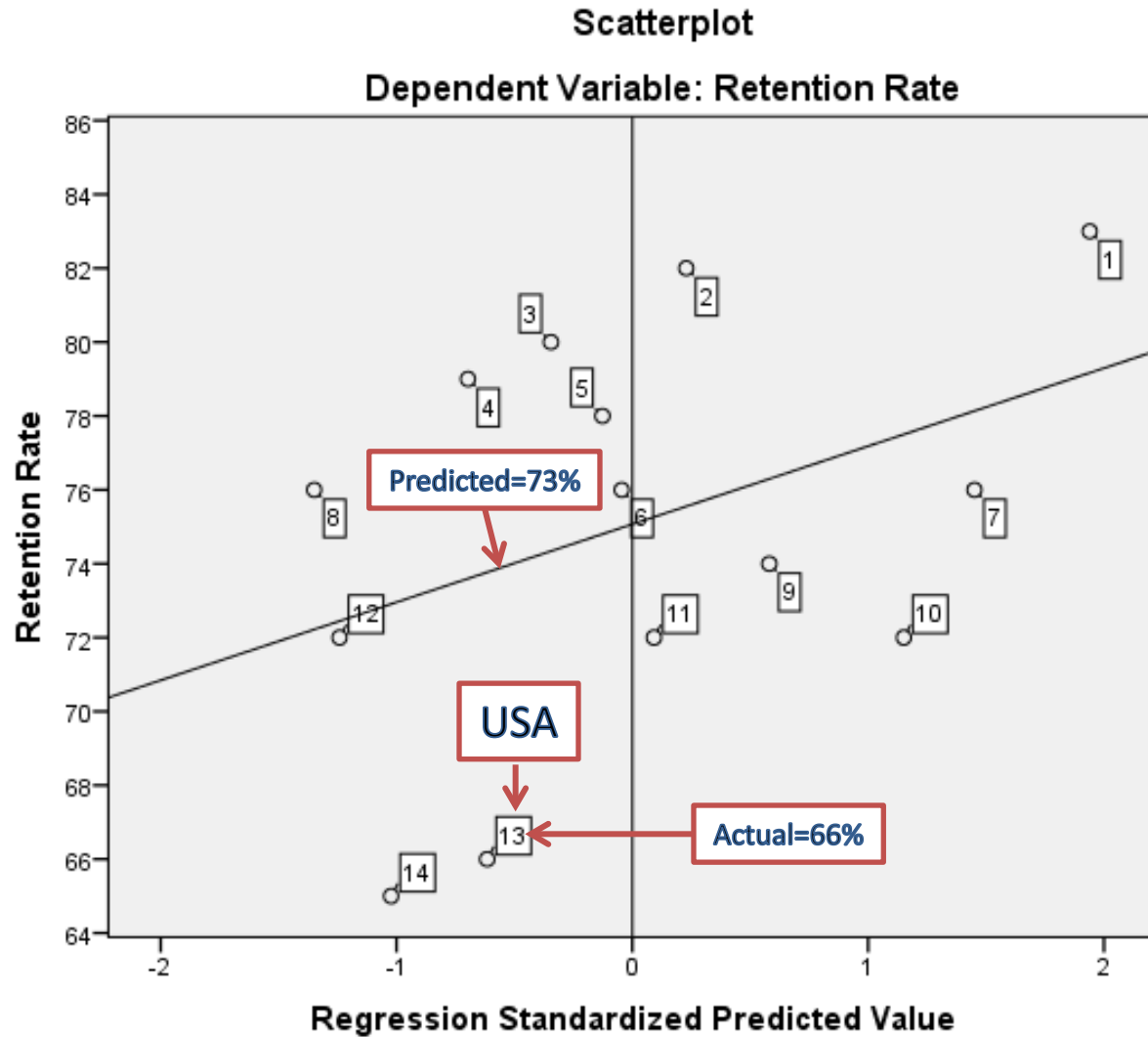
Six-Year Graduation Rate Trend

- Graduation rate remained relatively the same for past five years
 - 37% - 2004 freshman cohort
 - 38% - 2005 freshman cohort
 - 37% - 2006 freshman cohort
 - 33% - 2007 freshman cohort
 - 37% - 2008 freshman cohort

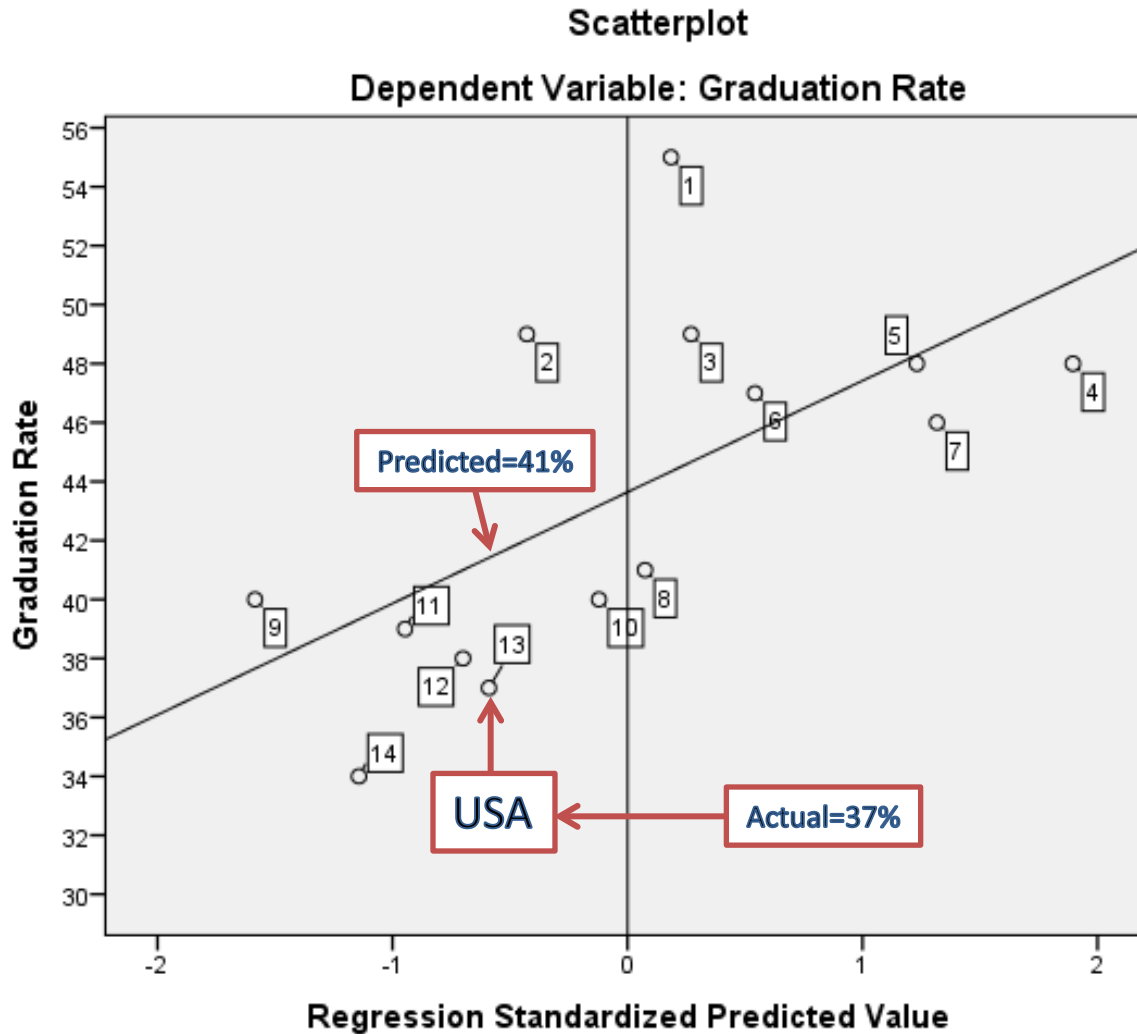
